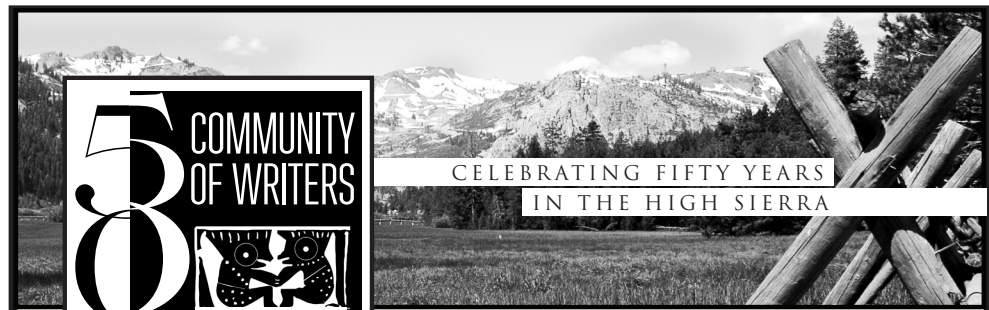
Dates: June 20 - 27, 2020

Deadline to apply: March 28, 2020

Each scholarship will include:
\$1,250 Tuition to Poetry Program
\$ 535 Twin Room Accommodations
\$1,785 Total Scholarship

Applicants will need to apply to the workshop by March 28 and pay the \$35 application fee. Fellows offered scholarships will need to submit a \$100 deposit (which will be refunded on arrival.) This is a scholarship for poets who have not previously attended the Poetry Workshop.
